Robert Goldsborough is a journalist and mystery writer. Following Rex Stout's death, he continued the Nero Wolfe mystery series. The first novel, *Murder in E Minor*, received a Nero Award. *Three Strikes You're Dead*, his first book in a series of period mysteries featuring reporter Snap Malek, was named the Best Historical Mystery by Love is Murder. *Terror at the Fair*, the fifth book in the series, received the Lovey Award in 2012. The Nero Wolfe series resumed in 2012 with *Nero Wolfe Meets Archie*, and the forthcoming *Death in the Ball Park*.


